### Recommended Equipment:

- Scout Uniform – Class “A”
  - Scout shirt
  - Pants/Shorts (optional)
  - Scout socks (optional)
- Duffle bag
- Sleeping bag
- Extra blanket
- Ground cloth
- Foam pad
- Pack cover/garbage bags
- Comfortable hiking shoes
- Poncho/rain gear
- Long pants
- Jacket (suitable for the weather)
- Sweatshirt
- Long sleeved shirt
- Extra pants (1-2 pair)
- Extra socks (1-2 pair)
- Extra shorts (1 pair)
- Extra t-shirt (2)
- Extra underwear (1 pair)
- Flashlight
- Extra batteries
- Coffee-cup style mug
- Mess Kit
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Hand towel
- Toilet paper (in plastic bag)
- Sunscreen
- Pocket knife (if you have the totin’ chip - or are working on it)
- Boy Scout handbook
- Pen/pencil and paper
- Compass
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Water bottle (optional)
- Insect repellent
- A hat (baseball, or whatever you prefer)
- Any medications you will need

### Depending on the weather:

- Water-proof boots
- Winter gloves
- Winter hat

### Optional Equipment:

- Camera/film
- Pillow
- Rope for clothes line
- Sunglasses
- Bandana
- Comb

### Do NOT Bring:

- Radios/Walkmans
- Hand-held games
- Comic books
- Magazines
- Sheath knife
- Food/candy/snacks

### Remember:

**Pack as much as you can into watertight zip lock bags!**

**As a general rule, you will need one pair of clothes for each day camping. Ex: 2 nights camping = 2 sets of pants/shorts/shirts/socks, plus at least one extra of each.**

**If you pack it, you will carry it!!**
